

President's Corner



This month, I thought I could give some insight into some of the interesting observations I have had in administering the annual eclectic competition, what with only three games left to improve our scores.

Over approximately 250 rounds captured, we have scored 45 four-pointers — Pauli, Corné and Tallies have recorded four each (Tallies has unfortunately had 2 on Hole #2!). Only Harold, with his eagle on Hole #7 at Silver Lakes, has a five-pointer.

Some of us are very fast out of the blocks, scoring well over the front nine, whilst others do better over the closing holes. On average, we fare worst between the 8th and 13th holes. Some of the leaders can improve their scores by converting those average two-pointers into three- or four-pointers. Of the leaders, Harold with 3 two-pointers, Pauli with 6, Tallies with 5, and Sydney with 5, are best placed to change two-pointers to better scores. Hole #17 is proving problematic, with the worst average points this year.
