Course Rating Revision for Pretoria Country Club

Over the last year or so the golf committee received many requests and enquiries from members and visitors querying why our course rating is at a stroke 71 although we're a par 72. The current course ratings' basic formula is purely a distance and altitude calculation. On that basis we just fall short of being rated as a stroke 72. However, there are other factors that can be applied to influence a course's rating. These include the width of the fairways (at the landing area), the number of hazards at the landing area, the size of the greens, the number of hazards protecting the greens, the speed and bounce of the greens, and whether the greens are raised or not. Anyone who knows this course will immediately recognise that PCC more than meets the criteria for a re-rating based on the above factors. Mr. Mellete Hendrickse (of GNGU) therefore recently assessed the course at the invitation of our GM and he has agreed to a rerating of PCC.

Effective from 01 November 2015 Pretoria Country Club's course rating will revert to a stroke 72 as befitting a course of our stature and dare I say difficulty.
