# "Senior Golfers Society Gauteng North"

# - September 2017 -

We enjoyed a very successful tour to Parys. The result of the two competitions played over the 26<sup>th</sup> August [in Better Ball Stableford format] and 27<sup>th</sup> August [in Individual Stableford format] was the following:

1. Free State won overall by scoring 275 points on 26<sup>th</sup> and 194 points on 27<sup>th</sup> for a total of 466 points



- 2. Gauteng North was placed second on 272 points [26<sup>th</sup>] and 192 points [27<sup>th</sup>] for a total of 464 points
- 3. Gauteng came third on 262 points [26<sup>th</sup>] and 189 points [27<sup>th</sup>] for a total of 451 points; and
- 4. Northern Cape finished fourth on 260 points [26<sup>th</sup>] and 185 points [27<sup>th</sup>] for a total of 445 points

A special word of thanks is due to John Loftus and Jan Van Der Merwe for their support in setting up the competitions and collating and adjudicating the results. I took on my own shoulders the, as it transpired, controversial responsibility for dropping the Pinehurst competition for the first time at this

tournament. I'm sure my fellow captains at the tournament Rob Wassenaar [Gauteng], Michael Vigne [Northern Cape] and Johan Grobelaar/ Reg Krohn [Free State] will see it reinstated next year? Controversy aside though; I would a like to thank these fellow captains and the entire contingent of 40 players for their generous support and camaraderie over the two days.

Members would have noticed an addition to the booking in procedures on our trusted web site. This requires that you swipe your card as a mandatory requirement, preferably before you commence a Seniors round. Obviously, that also means that it is incumbent on you to enter the score you achieved at the end of the round. This forms part of a general tightening up of the handicap system because of the fact that golfers often don't enter correct [or any scores] after rounds that are also, often, not properly registered. The matter is eloquently described in the latest edition of Handicaps SA and should be obligatory reading for every member of our exclusive community. Although I've had our recording habits accurately reported on for the last two years, I have waited patiently; and with some compassion; for this opportunity to appeal to your sense of honour to desist, one and all, from the practice of falsifying your record in any way. We are paragons of virtue and I want to be the last to open anyone's record for scrutiny and censure.

Projects that the committee are busy working on; arising from my earlier Newsletter and member feedback on merit selection for tournaments and the use of performance criteria for selection; are bearing fruit; and will be reported on in forthcoming Newsletters. I have noted the member concern about the entry criteria for tournaments and give you the committees commitment that entry will always be egalitarian; "on a first come first served basis" with merit applied ONLY when there is an over subscription.

So, although we, again, were pipped at the post in a tournament that we set up with pride and alacrity; we go forward in anticipation of our own society Championships and Gala Dinner in October. I hope to see you all soon at a dinner that will bear the hallmark of excellence as usual!!

## QUADRANGULAR 26/27 August - played in Parys and Vaal de Grace:


The Committee decided to maintain the 12man team as per last year's entries, except for Wim Fourie replacing Tallies Taljaard, who was unavailable.
